



Lake Naomi - Timber Trails Garbage Service FAQs

Who picks up my garbage?

Your Community Association contracts with County Waste to pick up your garbage. This cost is included in the yearly assessment you pay to the Pocono Pines Community Association (for Lake Naomi residents) or to the Timber Trails Community Association (for Timber Trails residents). What day is garbage picked up?

Garbage pick up is on Mondays in Timber Trails and on Tuesdays in Lake Naomi. Pick-up will begin at 6:00 a.m. on those days, so please have your garbage out by this time on your specified day.

Where do I place my garbage?

Effective immediately, we must begin moving all bins/cans/enclosures to within 20 FEET of the property line. Anything further than 20 feet will be considered "at the house service" and will be billed directly to the owner by County Waste at \$26 per month. Please REMEMBER, your front property line DOES NOT BEGIN AT THE EDGE OF PAVEMENT! Most properties begin approximately 25 feet off the center line of the paved road (see diagram on next page). Unless you are exactly sure where your property line is in the front, please use the center line of the road as a guide and place the bin WITHIN 20 FEET of your front property line and in CLEAR VIEW. There are contractors available that will help with this process if you are unable to move your bins/cans/enclosure by yourself. Please contact the Administrative Office for the names of service providers that will help you. A moveable RED flag on your enclosure is also suggested, but the garbage company is still obligated to stop at every property. If you want to have your garbage picked up further than 20 feet back or up at your house you must sign up for "at the house service" with Janessa Smith (see contact information above).

Where can I purchase a wooden trash shelter?

Wooden trash shelters are sold at the Blakeslee Flea Market on Saturdays and Sundays from 8:00 to 4:00. Delivery is available. They are also available for purchase from Mountain Landscaping (570-646-5335) or from the Bearicuda website at www.bearicuda.com. Plans and specifications are also available at the Administrative Office for do-it-yourselfers. Please note: trash shelters must be wooden and either be of natural color or match the color of your home.

Does Management recommend the use of bear proof garbage cans?

Yes. "Bearicuda" bins come in three different sizes and are available for sale through the Administrative Office. Please note that not all bearicuda bins will fit inside a standard size wooden trash shelter. See flyer on the back of this booklet for dimensions and pricing. Cans are advertised and sold by the manufacturer as "bear resistant". They are not guaranteed and occasionally are breached.

How many bags of garbage will be picked up?

Contracted service is for two cans, four bags (most cans hold two bags each). If you occasionally have extra, it will be picked up. If you have considerably more on a regular basis, please contact Association Manager, Wendi Freeman, for special arrangements.

What about recycling?

County Waste uses split hopper trucks which allow single stream recycling to be picked up at the same time as garbage. This means your glass, plastics #1-#7, cans and clean paper/cardboard can be placed in the same container for removal. See reverse side for acceptable recycling items. Recycling containers are available from County Waste at no charge. Please contact Janessa Smith if you require one.

What if I have a large item to dispose of?

Large items can be picked up at an additional cost. Please see bulk price list in this booklet. You must contact Janessa Smith to make arrangements for pick up.

Who do I call if my garbage is not picked up?

If you have any issues with garbage service, please contact Janessa at the number above or the Administrative Office.

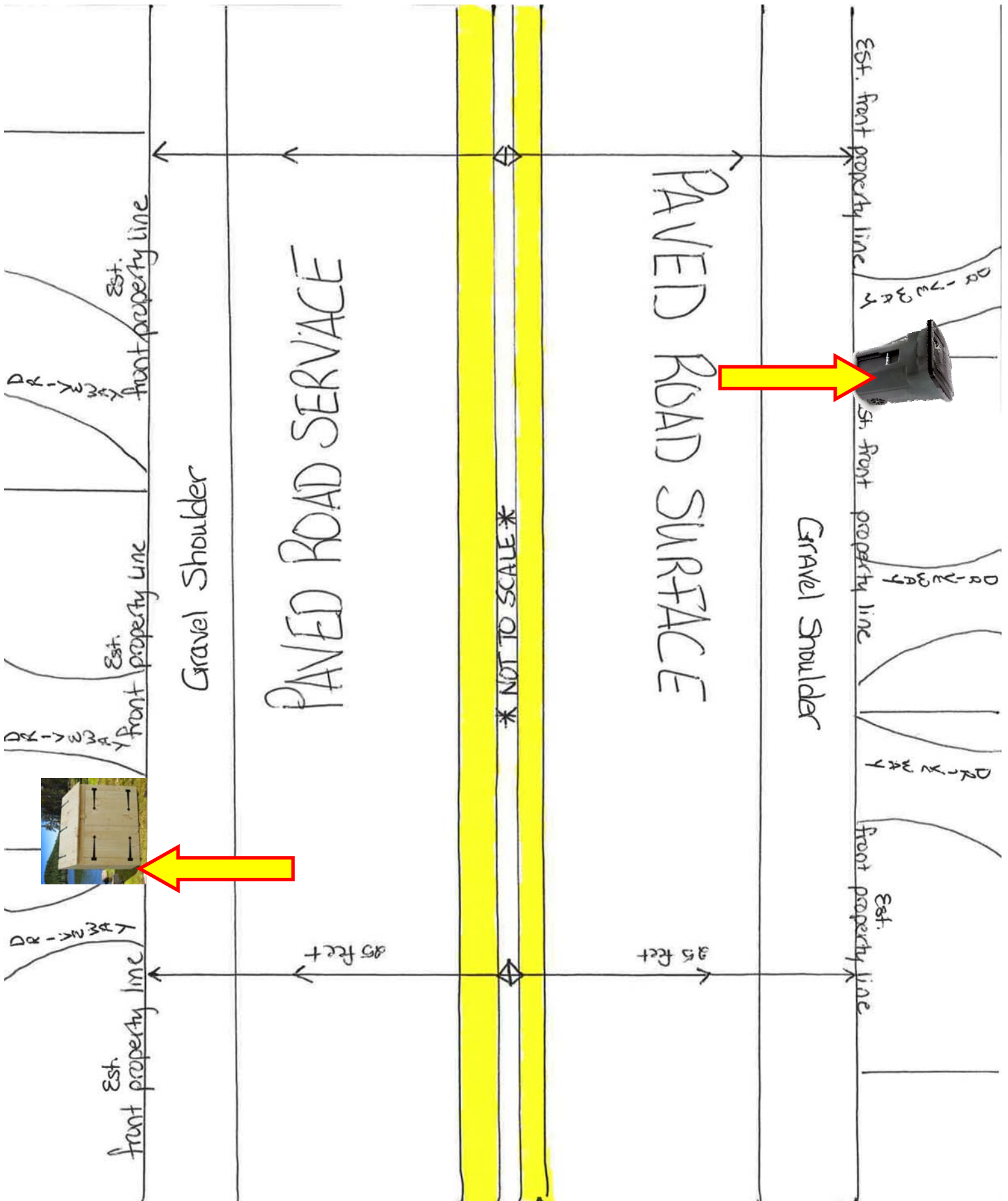
