Garbage Service

2024

As part of the Assessment paid to the TTCA in 2024, garbage service is provided to all homes in Timber Trails. Please see below for details of the service provided:

- Weekly pick-up of household garbage, up to 4 bags per household. Garbage must be properly contained in bags and then placed in a bear resistant can, placed in a wooden enclosure (located between 10 to 20 feet to the road pavement) or brought to the curb in just the can on garbage day. Currently, garbage is picked up on Mondays unless otherwise announced. Monday Morning collection begins at 6:00am.
- If you do not have a wooden enclosure at roadside, please understand that you must bring the can out the morning of collection and the can must be returned to the house after collection. Cans cannot remain at roadside.
- National Waste does offer “at the house service” for an additional fee. Owners interested in having the garbage picked up from their can at the house/garage for an additional fee should contact National Waste at 484-408-7350. Additional fees will be billed direct to the property owner by National Waste.
- Weekly pick up of single stream recyclables, currently on Thursdays. Begins at 6:00AM.

Due to the heavy black bear population in Pocono Pines, garbage left out in bags is unacceptable and will cause unwanted bear activity and garbage spills. In the event of a bear spill due to improperly contained garbage, litter patrol services will be dispatched, and the property owner will be billed a flat rate of \$300. If the action continues, a fine will also be levied. Please contain your garbage properly and alert your family and guests to do the same for the safety of all Timber Trails residents!
