



# Lake Naomi - Timber Trails Garbage Service FAQs



## Pocono Pines (Lake Naomi) Homeowners

Trash collection is not included in your Pocono Pines Community Association dues. Trash disposal is the homeowner's responsibility. You may use any trash hauler you wish or you may drop off at the Panther Waste - Sullivan Trail Transfer Station (570.646.5178) located at 353 Sullivan Trail, Long Pond, for a small fee. Please note that the Panther Waste Transfer Station is not currently open on Sundays. Below are two trash haulers that will provide individual collection services. Please contact them for more information regarding current pricing, pick up days and can location:

### **What day is garbage picked up?**

This will depend on which company is picking up your trash and their schedule for this area. The preferred vendor, National Waste picks up on Mondays starting at 6:00 AM. Single Stream Recycling is picked up on Fridays starting at 6:00AM.

### **Where do I place my garbage?**

All garbage must be properly contained in bags and then placed in a bear resistant can, placed in a wooden enclosure (located between 10-20 feet to the road pavement) or brought to the curb in the can on garbage day. If you do not have a wooden enclosure at the roadside, please understand that you must bring the can out the morning of collection and the can must be returned to the house after collection. Cans cannot remain at the roadside.

### **What if I have a large item to dispose of?**

The company that you chose will give you the information and pricing for bulk items. If using the preferred vendor, National Waste they can be contacted directly at the phone number above.

## Timber Trails Homeowners

The Timber Trails Community Association has contracted with National Waste Disposal to pick up your garbage. This cost is included in the yearly assessment you pay to the Association. Contracted service is for two cans, four bags (most hold two bags each) plus recycling.

### **What day is garbage picked up?**

Garbage pick up is on Mondays beginning at 6:00 AM. Single Stream Recycling pick up is on Thursdays beginning at 6:00 AM.

### **Where do I place my garbage?**

All garbage must be properly contained in bags and then placed in a bear resistant can, placed in a wooden enclosure (located between 10-20 feet to the road pavement) or brought to the curb in the can on garbage day. If you do not have a wooden enclosure at the roadside, please understand that you must bring the can out the morning of collection and the can must be returned to the house after collection. Cans cannot remain at the roadside.

### **Does National Waste offer at the house service?**

Yes, this service is available for an additional fee. Owners interested in having the garbage picked up from their can at the house or garage for an additional fee should contact National Waste at 484.408.7350. Additional fees will be billed directly to the property owner by National Waste.

### **Who do I call if my garbage is not picked up?**

### **What if I have a large item to dispose of?**

Large items can be picked up at an additional cost. You must contact National Waste at the number above to make arrangements for pick up.

These 'Stealth 2' bear resistant bins have locking lids that are disengaged by pressing on two paddles in the front of the receptacle. Simply flip the two small latches to open. The lid locks again as soon as it's lowered. The trick to keeping bears from breaking in is a gravity-activated mechanism that keeps the lid locked if the trash can is tipped on its side. You - or a bear - can press on the paddles and latches from now till Sunday and the lid will remain locked as long as it's on its side.
